North of England founders call for better support as the funding gap costs the UK economy £92bn

New research from Manchester-based Praetura Ventures shows the UK economy is losing out on a potential £92bn to GDP due to a shortfall in funding in the North.

The new report – What's Powering the Powerhouse? – finds that there is a lack of capital through equity funding, accelerators and support that amounts to £4.97bn in the North West, £3.8bn in Yorkshire & Humber and £1bn in the North East, totalling almost £10bn. Based on current output figures per business in 2022 in the North, the additional funding in each area would combine to create an additional £92bn in GDP.




