PharmaKure has launched a study to identify blood-based biomarkers in patients with Alzheimer's Disease

The study will test levels of blood biomarkers for stratification of Alzheimer's disease patients, who already have been tested with other diagnostic methods, either brain imaging by PET or amyloid deposits in cerebrospinal fluid (CSF).

Certain blood biomarkers of amyloid- β (Total, A β 40 and

A β 42), aggregated α -synuclein, aggregated Tau (Total and pTAU (181), NFL and DJ-1 have been associated with Alzheimer's Disease pathology. This study is to evaluate the relationship of aggregated forms of all these biomarkers in patient blood compared to historical PET scan and CSF findings.


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Leveraging protein DNA/RNA interactions in drug discovery

A new method to rapidly assess and step through the hit-to-lead process with minimal expenditure on wet-chemistry

Hit Expander: A new method to rapidly assess and step through the hit-to-lead process with minimal expenditure on wet-chemistry

You may have seen a recent paper by Yuan Hu and Ingo Mügge from Alkermes on 'In Silico Positional Analogue Scanning with Amber GPU-TI'. The idea behind positional analogue scanning (PAS) is relatively simple: you have a hit molecule, and you'd like to know what changes (and in what directions) are likely to lead to an increase in potency. Would adding something in the 3-position be a good idea? If so, what sort of functional group should we add? Traditionally this relied largely on the skill and judgement of expert chemists to decide which vectors looked good (both from a synthetic feasibility point of view and from any pre-existing knowledge of the SAR), and what changes to make (often following, either directly or in spirit the venerable Topliss Tree).
