Looking 'under the hood': using pyflare to streamline hit identification

Flare ™ is a drug-design software platform which can be used to predict whether compounds will bind to a given protein target, using techniques such as molecular docking and Electrostatic Complementarity ™ (EC) analysis which compares the electrostatics of the bound putative ligand with the binding site of the target protein. The Flare GUI can seamlessly run such calculations on a maximum of 10,000 ligands, but what happens when we have millions of ligands? In such a case, it would not be possible to store all these structures and run calculations within the GUI. This is where using the pyflare command line can be very useful.


