Submit your technical posters for the 2016 BioInfect Conference - Thursday 3rd November,
Alderley Park, Cheshire

Abstract submission deadline: Friday 21st October 2016

BioInfect is a major 1-day conference, that will look at the critical issues relating to the development of new anti-infectives and the endemic problem of resistance. The development of antibiotics has been vital to our survival, yet the rise of antimicrobial resistance is threatening to make them ineffective in the future.

Poster submissions will provide an opportunity to showcase on-going research projects and speculative or innovative work in progress relating to the development of new anti-infectives. The posters are intended to provide authors and participants with the ability to connect with each other and engage in discussions about the work.

Authors must submit an abstract of no more than 300 words in English outlining aims, objectives, methodology and conclusions for consideration by the conference organising committee. Authors will be informed of acceptance or otherwise by Monday 24th October.

If accepted, authors must prepare and bring to the event at their own cost a poster in English of A0 (841 x 1189mm) size in either portrait or landscape format. Poster boards will be provided for authors to display to delegates throughout the conference. Authors must ensure that the poster is staffed by at least one person from your organisation during all breaks.
